

ART HISTORY COURSE - A

Visits to museums, churches and monuments

The course is held in Italian and offers the possibility to perfect the language and at the same time visit the city. The course consists of guided tours to the main museums, churches and monuments of Florence. It consists of 3 weekly meetings for a total of 12 guided tours to different locations in the city each month.

The guided tours, which last approximately 2 hours, are generally from 12.30 onwards, compatible with Italian language and applied arts courses.

It is possible to start the course every week, the minimum attendance is 1 week and the maximum attendance is 4 weeks.

The program is communicated two weeks before the guided visits take place and it can include the following places of interest:
